ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE ONE, AIRPORTS AND AIRCRAFT, TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 301, ENTITLED “VEHICLE OPERATIONS IN PUBLIC AREAS,” TO REQUIRE THAT EACH COMMERCIAL GROUND TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE OPERATING AT TULSA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT OBTAIN A PERMIT PURSUANT TO THE COMMERCIAL GROUND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES POLICY ADOPTED BY THE TULSA AIRPORTS IMPROVEMENT TRUST, AND AMENDING TITLE ONE, CHAPTER SIX, SECTION 600, ENTITLED “FINE SCHEDULE,” TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A FINE FOR OPERATING WITHOUT A PERMIT UNDER SUCH COMMERCIAL GROUND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES POLICY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Title 1, Chapter 3, Section 301, “Vehicle Operations in Public Areas”, be and the same is hereby amended to add the following new provision as follows:

“E. No person shall operate a commercial ground transportation service vehicle within the boundaries of the Tulsa International Airport without holding a current and valid permit issued by TAIT in accordance with TAIT’s Ground Transportation Services Policy, as it may be amended and in effect from time to time, and agreeing to comply with such policy.”

Section 2. That Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Title 1, Chapter 6, Section 600, “Fine Schedule”, be and the same is hereby amended to add the following new violation:

Section 3. *That an emergency is now declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, by reason whereof this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption, approval, and publication.*

TEXT OF CODIFIED AMENDMENT
TITLE 1, AIRPORTS AND AIRCRAFT
CHAPTER 3, SECTION 301
VEHICLE OPERATIONS IN PUBLIC AREAS

Section 301. - Vehicle operations in public areas.

- A. No person shall cruise the passenger terminal complex for the purpose of soliciting business or fares.
- B. No person shall make repairs to a vehicle in the passenger terminal complex unless such repairs are for an emergency, i.e. flat tire or dead battery.
- C. No person shall park to load or unload passengers in the passenger terminal complex in any areas other than those designated by appropriately installed signage.
- D. No person shall fail to obey promptly any lawful command by any Airport Officer, Airport Parking Inspector, City Police Officer, or other duly authorized representative of the Director or the City, when so identified.
- E. No person shall operate a commercial ground transportation service vehicle within the boundaries of the Tulsa International Airport without holding a current and valid permit issued by TAIT in accordance with TAIT's Ground Transportation Services Policy, as it may be amended and in effect from time to time, and agreeing to comply with such policy.

TEXT OF CODIFIED AMENDMENT
TITLE 1, AIRPORTS AND AIRCRAFT
CHAPTER 6, SECTION 600
FINE SCHEDULE

Section 600. - Fine schedule.

In lieu of an appearance before the Municipal Court, the City may designate, by ordinance, the penalties to be paid for the offenses which may be satisfied by payment at the Court. Bail, in the form of a "preset fine," is authorized by 11 O.S. 2010, § 28-113(c). The amount of bail for the designated offenses hereinafter described shall be the amount of fines and costs, including any penalty assessments and/or fees, provided for in Oklahoma Statutes and City Ordinances. This section establishes preset fines only for those offenses where the violator signs a written promise to appear and no court appearance is scheduled by the issuing officer. This section shall not apply to those offenses that cause the violator to be arrested.
